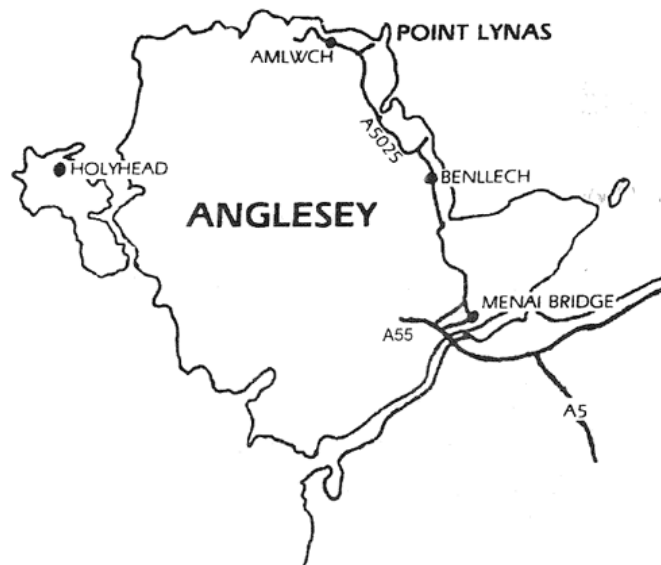
- Deep sink, with free hot water for washing utensils

## Directions

Cross from the mainland onto Anglesey over the Britannia Bridge. At the Anglesey end, take care to take the SECOND EXIT LEFT - signposted BENLLECH, AMLWCH.

Follow signs for Amwlch, passing through the villages of Pentraeth and Benllech.

Two miles after Benllech, turn left at the roundabout. After three miles, the road becomes three lanes, leading to the Pen-y-Sarn bypass (village on the right).

Over the crest of the hill at Cerrig Man, Anglesey Mowers is on the right. Turn right here for Llaneilian, after half a mile pass a right turn and bear right at T-Junction. Follow the bends, passing Llaneilian Church on the left. At the end of short straight turn sharp left. A telephone box is on the right and the park entrance is 300 metres on the left.

We are 17 miles from the Britannia Bridge.

## Welcome to Point Lynas Caravan Park

Point Lynas Caravan Park is located on the north east corner of Anglesey, overlooking Point Lynas where there is an automatic lighthouse and close to Porth Eilian Bay.

Porth Eilian is a small, sheltered rocky cove, 200 metres from the park entrance. It is safe for swimming, boating and fishing. Access to the beach is by slipway suitable for launching small boats. There are wonderful walks along coastal footpaths, where you can see wild flowers, sea birds, seals and harbour porpoises. Climb Mynydd Eilian and enjoy superb views along the coast and across to Snowdonia. Parys Mountain and Heritage Park is nearby. Just relax and unwind in this select 'away from it all' corner of Anglesey.



## Nearby Facilities

- Shops – Amlwch 1 ½ miles away.
- Local inns for eating out easily reached by car.
- Access to coastal path 200m from park entrance.
- Heritage centre at Amlwch Port and Parys Mountain Copper Trail.
- Leisure Centre, Amlwch, swimming & children's activity mornings.
- Bird watching. Excellent for coastal species.
- Sea fishing, many local spots and boat trips from Amlwch Port.
- Fresh water fishing at Llyn Alaw and many coarse fishing locations on the island.
- Oriel Centre, Llangefni has historical & art exhibitions and public golf course.
- Holyhead port, gateway to Ireland.

## Caravan Holiday Homes

51 privately owned caravans, well spaced out in five acres of gently sloping lawns. Most pitches have sea views, some have private patios and sun terraces.

All caravans are connected to mains electricity, piped gas, water and sewage, with car parking adjacent to caravan. Hardstandings for winter parking. Amenity building with washing machine and tumble dryer for your convenience.

The park is open 1st March to 4th January in the following year.
